Our Town

Mlada Boleslav is named after its founder prince Boleslav II, called Boleslav the Younger. New dynamics was brought in the 19th century when in the town and its environs the first workshops and factories were established. The history of the most famous one, the car factory, started in the year 1895 when Mr Laurin, a mechanic from Turnov and Mr Klement, a bookseller from Mladá Boleslav set up a company producing bicycles. Today the car company employs one half of the population of the town of 43,000 inhabitants. In Mlada Boleslav, there are many unique monuments which are worth seeing. For example city Castle, the House of Prayer of the Bohemian Brethren, the Municipal Theatre or famous Skoda Auto Museum.

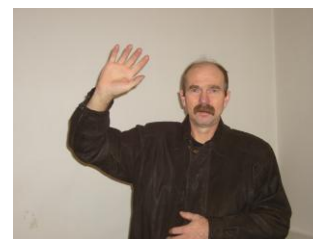


Our school
